**FEMA** has opened two centers in Middle Tennessee to help flood victims.

The first is at the 100 Hundred Oaks Mall in Berry Hill, and the other is in Centerville at the Centerville Community Church of Christ on North Central Avenue.

The centers will be open 7 days a week from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. and they will

be there for quite some time.

Those who need federal help to recover, should go to [www.disasterassistance.gov](http://www.disasterassistance.gov) or [fema.gov](http://fema.gov). Or you can call 1-800-621-3362.

Flood victims must register with FEMA to start the process of getting any sort of federal help.

After you register, expect a phone call to set a time for a visit to assess the damage.

The turn-around time to receive federal dollars is approximately a week to 10 days. Direct deposit to a bank account is the quickest way to get your money.
