On May 1, 2017, the City received information regarding the repair of the bridge and were told that Metro had decided to use their bridge funding to do the project and that the total cost to the citizens of Millersville will be \$1,500 instead of \$70,000 in tax payer money. This is a huge savings to all residents! The project will most likely take another year more to be completed. An actual timeline is not available at this time. This has been a two year long process and residents in that area have been greatly inconvenienced since the bridge closure. We are glad that it was finally resolved and can move forward.

Awards and Recognitions

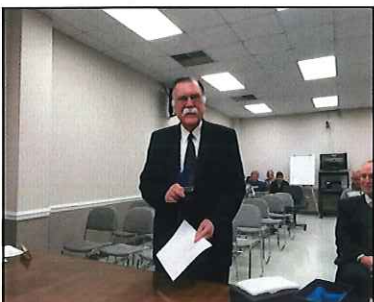
