Monday, November 28, 2022 at 5:00 P.M. at Millersville City Hall

The Millersville Board of Commissioners held their special meeting at the Millersville City Hall on Tuesday, November 28, 2022 with the following board members present: David Gregory, Mayor; Cristina Templet, Vice Mayor. 1. Call to Order.

Commissioner Templet voted for Cristina Templet

Commissioner Dorris voted for Milton Dorris

Majority ruled in favor of Milton Dorris as Vice Mayor.

5. Commissioner comments.

Commissioner Bell stated that he is looking forward to the next couple of years. He wants to work together for the benefit of the City and to make sure that the employees are taken care of.

Commissioner Gregory stated that it has been an honor to serve in any capacity with the City and that he is here to work together with all of the Commissioners and the City Manager.
