- 5) Approve the Minutes of the Planning Commission Meeting(s):
 - a) February 12, 2019:

Chairman Fox requests the Commission to approve the February 12, 2019 Meeting Minutes. Ms. Alisa Huling made the motion to "approve the February 12, 2019 Meeting Minutes as presented." Vice Chairman Petty seconded the motion.

7) Action Item(s):

a) Chapter 90 Zoning Amendment – Transmission and Communications Towers and Stations:

Mr. Barr stated that the Planning Commission wanted this to be continued form last month's meeting to this meeting to provide more information. Sumner County EMA Executive Director, Ken Weidner, came to speak to the City Commission in a workshop regarding the emergency communication towers and antennas and the need/other details as to what this proposed change will allow. This addition of language is complimentary to the /tower and antenna section of the Sumner County Code. Mr. Barr is recommending approval of the amendment to Sec. 90-551.

Chairman Fox asked Mr. Barr if this was to amend Article 3 Subdivision 5 Section 90-551 to include antennas or towers for municipal purposes to be exempt. Mr. Barr stated yes, these facilities would be exempt from Planning Commission approval but would require approval by the City Commission. Chairman Fox asks for a motion to be made to approve the amendment to Sec. 90-551 to include antennas or towers for municipal purposes to be exempt. Vice Chairman Petty seconded the motion. Secretary Gregory asked Mr. Barr if the City will have to pay anything, aside from equipment needed. White House Utility District is providing a portion of their property to put up a Tower.

Motion carried by Unanimous Vote. (4-aye, 0-nay)

a) Discuss existing Sign Ordinance & Violations:

Mr. Barr presents the Commissioners with a handout regarding Sign Ordinances for the City for them to discuss in an open forum. *Commissioner Mr. Bell arrives to the meeting*

b) Discuss Standards for Community Campgrounds:

Mr. Barr presents the Commissioners with a handout regarding Standards for Community Campgrounds in the City for them to discuss in an open forum. Mr. Barr stated that there is a new buyer for a portion of the Bethel Road Campground who is working with the current owner to get everything up to standard.
