Millersville Board of Commissioners Special Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, November 24, 2020 at 5:30 P.M. Millersville Community Center, 1181 Louisville Highway

The Millersville Board of Commissioners held their special meeting at the Millersville Community Center on Tuesday, November 24, 2020 with the following board members present: Tim Lassiter, Mayor; Keith Bell, Vice-Mayor. Commissioners: David Gregory and Larry Petty. Also, present: City Manager Steve Collie, City Recorder Holly Murphy; Amy Hutchison, Recorder Pro Tem. Absent: Commission Milton Dorris.

1. Call to Order.

Mayor Lassiter called the meeting to order at 5:30 P.M.

2. Invocation and Pledge to the Flag.

City Manager Steve Collie gave the invocation followed by the Pledge to the Flag of the United States led by Mayor Tim Lassiter.

5. Nominations for Vice Mayor.

Mr. Collie called for nominations for Vice Mayor. Commissioner Gregory nominated Keith Bell. There were no other nominations.

Mr. Collie called for a vote on the nomination of Keith Bell for Vice Mayor. (Vote 4 yea -1 abstention, with Mr. Bell abstaining.). Majority ruled in favor of Keith Bell as Vice Mayor.

6. Citizen comments. (Limited to 3 minutes per speaker). There were no comments.

7. Commissioner comments.

Commissioner Gregory stated that he appreciated everyone stepping up and that he looks forward to serving with the newly elected Commission.

Vice Mayor Bell thanked everyone for their support and there is still lots of work to do. He complimented Mayor Lassiter on moving the City progressively forward.

Commissioner Long thanked everyone for their support. He takes this position serious and he

will work hard for the betterment of the City and to move the City forward.

Commissioner Templet thanked everyone for their support and she is excited for the progress of the City.

Mayor Lassiter welcomed the new commissioners. He thanked everyone for coming out to vote in record numbers. He thanked Vice Mayor Bell for his comments but stated that the entire board had worked hard the last few years. He thanked Larry Petty for his service and he looks forward to working with him on other boards.

Mr. Collie thanked Mr. Petty and Mr. Dorris for their service to the City. He congratulated the newly elected commissioners.
