## INSTRUCTIONS

### Line by line instructions:

1. List the total number of rooms rented during the month.
2. List room rental revenue whether or not received for the occupancy in the hotel.
3. Take the amount on line 2 and multiple it by .025
4. Multiply line 3 by 0.005
5. Subtract line 4 from line 3 if your return and remittance will made before the due date, (the 20<sup>th</sup> of the following month). If your payment is on time, go to line 11 and enter the tax due.
6. **If your return is late**, multiply line 4 by .12 and the number of 30 day periods late. Enter the amount of interest here.
7. **If your return is late**, calculate the penalty at 1% per month or portion of month. Enter the penalty calculated here.
8. Add line 6 and 7. Enter the result here. This is the total interest and penalty.
9. Add line 8 and line 3. Enter the result here. This is the total due.
