ARTICLE IV. - FIREWORKS

Sec. 34-101. - Use restricted.

It is hereby declared unlawful and a violation of this article for any individual to use within the city any pyrotechnics commonly known as fireworks, other than the permissible items set forth in T.C.A. § 68-22-108 and other than during dates and times provided in this section. The permissible items may be used on the following dates and times:

- (1) July 3 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.
 - (2) July 4 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m. (midnight).
- (3) July 5 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.
 - (4) On the first Saturday following the 4th of July between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m. (midnight).
- (5) Beginning at 9:00 a.m. on December 31 and continuing until 1:00 a.m. on January 1.
- (6) The Millersville City Commission may, by resolution, temporarily amend the dates and times for permissible use of fireworks for special events or to coincide with local, state or national observances of holidays.
