

**Millersville Board of Commissioners
Minutes of Regular Meeting**

Tuesday, November 20, 2018 at 5:30 P.M.

The Millersville Board of Commissioners held their regular monthly meeting at City Hall on Tuesday, November 20, 2018 with the following board members present: Tim Lassiter, Mayor; Vice Mayor Keith Bell. Commissioners: Bonnie Coleman, David Gregory and Milton Dorris. Also present: Interim City Manager Holly Murphy; Amy Hutchison, Recorder Pro Tem.

1. Call to Order.

Mayor Lassiter called the meeting to order at 5:31 P.M.

2. Invocation and Pledge to the Flag.

Pastor Charles Anderson gave the invocation followed by the Pledge to the Flag of the United States led by Mayor Lassiter.

3. Approval of minutes from the October 16, 2018 Regular Commission Meeting.

Vice Mayor Bell made a correction to page six in the Commissioner Comments; the word "continuance" should be "contiguous".

With no further discussion, Vice Mayor Bell moved to approve the minutes from the October 16, 2018 Regular Commission Meeting, seconded by Commissioner Coleman. (Vote 5 yea – 0 nay.) Motion carried.

4. Approval of the October 2018 Financial Reports.

Commissioner Coleman made a motion to approve the October 2018 Financial Reports, seconded by Vice Mayor Bell. (Vote 5 yea – 0 nay.) Motion carried.

5. Installation of Newly Elected Commissioners

City Judge William Johnson administered the Oath of Office to Bonnie Coleman and David Gregory.

Mayor Lassiter turned the meeting over to Interim City Manager Holly Murphy for Agenda Items 6 and 7.

6. Nominations for Mayor.

Ms. Murphy called for nominations for Mayor. Commissioner Coleman nominated Tim Lassiter. There were no other nominations.

Ms. Murphy called for a vote on the nomination of Tim Lassiter for Mayor. (Vote 4 yea – 1 abstention, with Mr. Lassiter abstaining.) Majority ruled in favor of Tim Lassiter as Mayor.

7. Nominations for Vice Mayor.

Ms. Murphy called for nominations for Vice Mayor. Commissioner Gregory nominated Keith Bell. There were no other nominations.

Ms. Murphy called for a vote on the nomination of Keith Bell for Vice Mayor. (Vote 4 yea – 1 abstention, with Mr. Bell abstaining.) Majority ruled in favor of Keith Bell as Vice Mayor.

Ms. Murphy turned the meeting back over to Mayor Lassiter.

8. Commissioner Comments.

Commissioner Gregory thanked everyone that turned out to vote. He stated that it was the largest turnout that he has seen for a mid-term election in the City. He wished everyone a Happy Thanksgiving.

Vice Mayor Bell stated that he appreciates the confidence that the Board of Commissioners has shown him in being Vice Mayor. He also wished everyone a Happy Thanksgiving.

Commissioner Coleman thanked the people for voting and that she is looking forward to serving her third term on the Commission. She stated that there are a lot of good things coming to the City including the addition to City Hall and wished everyone a Happy Thanksgiving.

Commissioner Dorris appreciates everyone serving on the Board. He stated that we have a good Commission and he really enjoys working with everybody. He ended by wishing everyone a Happy Thanksgiving.

Mayor Lassiter thanked everyone for their confidence and that he has had the pleasure to be part of the best Board the City has ever had. He is looking forward to the next two years. He closed with wishing everyone a Happy Thanksgiving.


