When does the parade take place?

- o The parade is on Saturday, 12/12/20, beginning at 2:00pm.

Who may participate in the parade?

- o Any local group or business may participate in the parade and advertise on their float or vehicle.
- o We invite any form of motorized vehicles, animals, or bicycles.

What is the theme of the parade?

- o The parade theme is Cozy Hometown Christmas. We encourage parade participants to decorate their vehicles and floats in any style that they would like.
- o Please no Santa costumes! We will have a Santa Claus at the end of the parade, so we ask that you not have anyone dressed in a Santa costume, though Santa decorations are fine.

Is there a fee?

- o The parade is free to the participants.

What is the parade route?

- o The parade will begin on C Smith Road and Highway 31W in front of Wade's Lawn Service. It will head south on Highway 31W to the Paschall Truck Lines parking lot where vehicles can be staged to pick up participants, if needed.
- o Participants may begin lining up at 1:00pm. The order will be first come/first serve, with the Grand Marshall leading the parade and Santa Clause ending the parade.
- o All participants must be in line at 1:45pm to be included in the parade.

Can we throw candy to parade goers?

- o Yes, you may throw candy, but we ask that it be securely packaged. Candy with a wrapper that only covers a portion of the candy is not allowed. For instance, Dum-Dums or Tootsie Pops where the wrapper only covers the candy and not the stick will not be allowed.
- o We encourage putting candy in treat bags or plastic baggies to make it easier for clean-up.

Is amplified music allowed?

- o Yes, but please be aware that the parade will pass through residential areas and be sensitive to noise levels.
